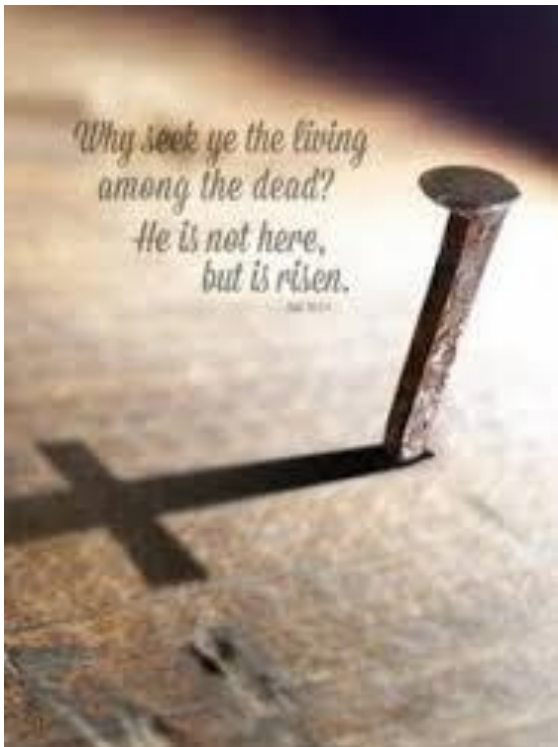
### Earth hour...
