New high school option...

Our grade 6 and 7 children brought home a flyer from Enko Ferndale, a new international secondary school opening in January 2017 in Ferndale, Randburg, Johannesburg.

Enko Ferndale is part of Enko Education, an Africa-wide network of more affordable international schools. Their goal is to provide learners across Africa with a launchpad to the world's best universities. In that



regard, they are opening a secondary school in Ferndale, open to learners from grade 8 to 12. Enko Ferndale will offer the Cambridge Curriculum from grade 8 to 10, and then the International Baccalaureate curriculum for Grades 11 and 12. The International Baccalaureate is one of the most recognised and sought-after high school diplomas in the world. Already, this academic year's Enko graduates have received early admissions to UK universities.

Enko Ferndale is located on the Gautrain bus route, allowing our learners from Solid Foundations Primary School to easily access it via the Rhodesfield Gautrain station, which is located only 9km away from Solid Foundations.
