We would like to remind our families that the fenced-off field (labelled "Community Veld Project") adjacent to our school does not belong to us, and that we are using municipal land for our P.T. lessons and as a soccer field. Although we have tried, for almost 7 years, to use all the correct legal channels in obtaining lease rights on this land, our application simply "gets stuck between departments" at municipal level.

As such, we do want to give your heads up that, legally, we cannot be held liable for any accidents or injuries incurred on this field, as it is not our property.

That being said, we are happy to mention that we haven't had a single injury to date on the field and for our pupils' safety we do keep the field locked from the school side so that our pupils are only permitted on this ground during breaks when they are supervised by an adult.

In addition to the above safety measures, we have conducted a fire drill at school today. This is a standard safety precaution that we practise annually at our school. We are proud to announce that it took us exactly 5 minutes to evacuate the entire building ©!

If any of these payments are yours, please let us know as soon as possible. Thank you.

For confidentiality reasons, our accounting programme only generates and sends school statements to ONE email address per family. If you did not receive your January statement, or if you would like to change the address the statement is emailed to, please let us know.
