## My daddy and me...

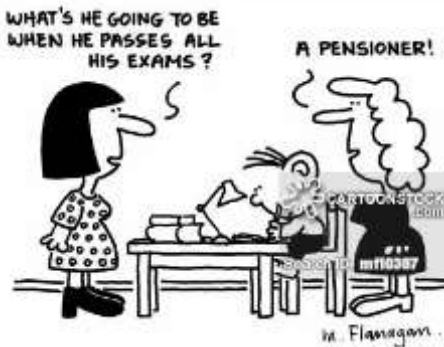
