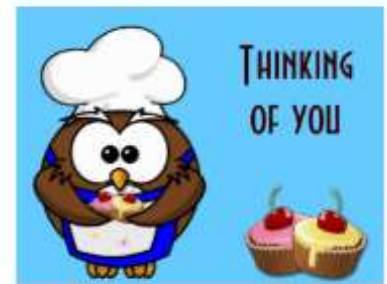


Drama, drama, drama...
