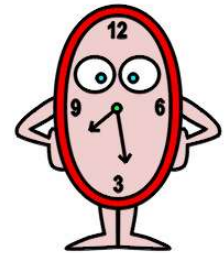
Kathryn will announce all items that have made it into the actual Talent Shows (see the hall door for confirmation).
