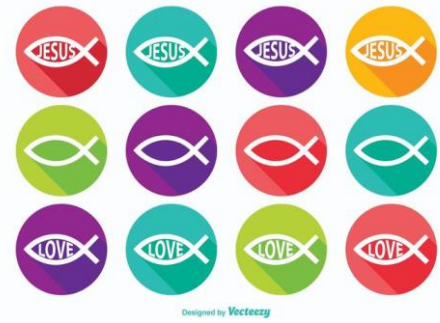
Please return all indemnity forms before next week.
