

W.H.O. DEWORMING CAMPAIGN...

We have been approached by the Department of Health and the Department of Education who have joined hands in implementing the W.H.O. campaign of eradicating worms in South Africa's primary school children. Your child will receive a letter today requesting your consent. Please complete the details if you approve of your child's participation in this deworming campaign.

Children who have worms may have some symptoms like:

- Tummy aches
- Fatigue
- Gas/ bloating
- Weight loss
- Runny noses and "allergy like" symptoms

However, some children with worms experience no noticeable symptoms for years.

Please note that if your child is waiting for you or for transport after doing an extra mural, they will be sent to the "waiting zone" by the troll bridge, under the safe and watchful eye of Teacher Joanne. This is a grassy area, blocked off on four sides and is shaded.
