Art attack...

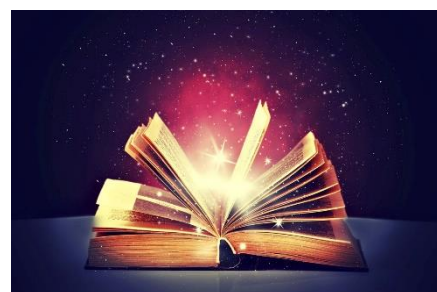
Our hall is looking quite artsy with sample work from our senior primary pupils filling up the walls. If you get a moment, please remember to enjoy the hard work.
