

After Care arrangements for Holiday Club...

If you would like your child to join Holiday Club but you can't get them to the church - we will be using the school bus to transport 25 children to the church and back. It will be on a first come first serve basis. There will be R20 for the week petrol fee charged.

If the child is not aftercare - the child will need to be fetched immediately after being dropped at the school, otherwise, you will be charged for aftercare. For aftercare children - Holiday Club fees are over and above the normal aftercare fee. Holiday club is R80 for the week and R20 for transport to the church (if required).

Holiday club forms can be collected from Mrs Obbes and need to be returned to her with the money before June 7^{th} if you want to book your seat on the bus. If you are using your own transport to Holiday Club - the you can enrol on the 17^{th} June at the church. Or collect a form from Mrs Obbes.
