Remember that we break up at 10h00.

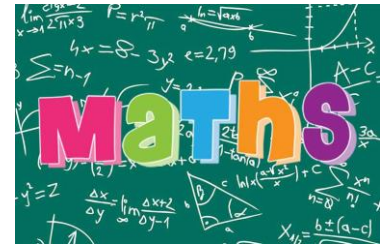


Calling all bookworms...

On the topic of books...

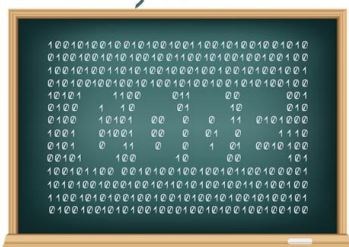
