Report card time...

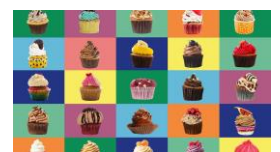

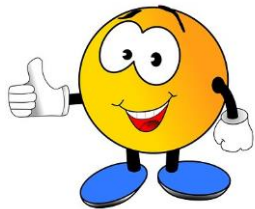
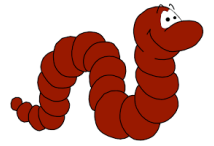


Ziping fun...

Our children will be dewormed slightly ahead of schedule (this week Friday). Please return your consent forms if you have not already done so.

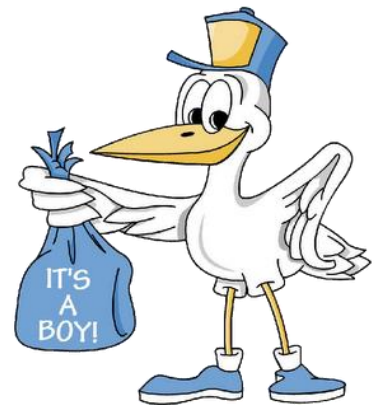


School survey results...
