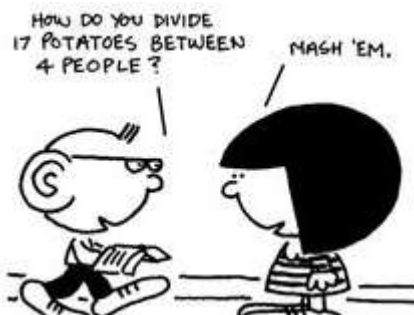
Our seniors had an uncomfortable but delightful sleepover last night. In spite of the weather, our children made happy memories!
