## SPORTS DAY...3 more sleeps!

A reminder about our Sports Day on Saturday.

Date: Saturday the 12<sup>th</sup> of March 2022

Time: Preschoolers 7h30 for 7h50. Grade 1-7 8h30 for 9h00.

Expected ending times: Preschoolers 9h30 and Grade 1-7 11h30

Where: Laerskool Mooifontein (see map)

Dress Code: PE uniforms (pre-schoolers may wear grey or maroon shirts and Grade 1-7 pupils may wear grey or coloured house shirts). Bibs will be provided on the day to divide children into their correct "houses".

What to bring: Parents must bring chairs or blankets to sit on. Don't forget sunscreen and sunhats. Mooifontein tuck shop will be selling hotdogs, hamburgers and chicken wraps as well as sweets and coldrink, but we recommend you pack in extra water.

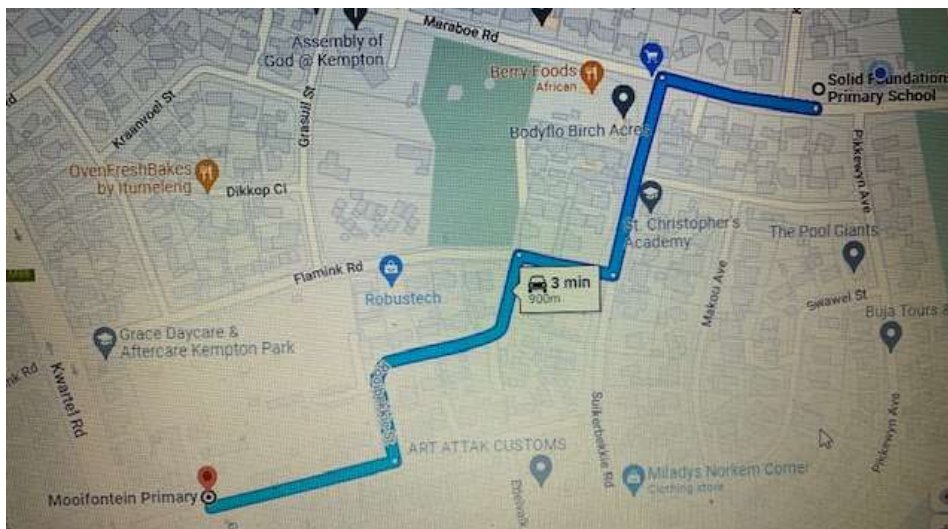
What to do on arrival: Please take your child to the bathroom on arrival. Thereafter, preschool children can wait for the fun to start by sitting on a plastic ground sheet on the field, or stay standing close to their teachers. On arrival the Grade 1-7 pupils will be directed to get a bib from their sports house area and a name-tag from their homeroom teacher. All Grade 1-7 pupils then wait on the field for the opening parade.

Where to park: There will be parking available inside Mooifontein's grounds. If this parking is full, you may need to park on the pavement surrounding the school.

Where to sit: Parents are free to choose their best spots for viewing. Please avoid any taped off areas though (e.g. near the finish line).

**Every child (Grade RRR-7) is expected to attend Sports Day. Please RSVP to your child's teacher if you are unable to attend.**
