#### Welcome back...


#### Civvies tickets...

We are excited to announce that our 2022 "Young Entrepreneurs Day" is scheduled for <u>Saturday the 5<sup>th</sup> of November this year.</u> We haven't been able to treat our children to this exciting event since before CoVid days. For our new families, "Young Entrepreneurs Day" means that <u>each child in the school (from Grade RRR to 7) is invited to host a stall.</u>
