A few reminders:

- Market Day starts at 9h00 and concludes at 12h00, but stall owners can start setting up at 8h00 already.
- We will give you school desks for your stall, and you can set up under the trees on either playground. If you'd like a bigger stall, please bring your own tables and gazebo.
- If your stall requires electricity, please buy an electricity voucher from the school for R50.
- During the day, keep a record of your PROFIT, and pay 10% to the school at the end of the day. (We rely on your honesty in this regard).
- Remember to organise a kitty for yourself e.g. if you are charging R5, you'd better have a lot of R10 notes and R5 coins to give as change to customers.
- Remember to make a poster advertising your product and price. The poster needs to be stuck on your table (so remember prestick or tape) so that people know what you are selling or doing and how much it will cost!
- Organise family members to help out at certain times at your stall, so you can walk around and enjoy the day yourself too.
- Please help clean up at the end of the Market Day by returning your school desk and chair to the class you took it from, and by picking up any litter lying around.

We are expecting all of our families to pop in (even if you aren't hosting a stall) together with friends and neighbours. Our "Young Entrepreneurs Day" is usually a day of incredible memory-making fun and memories.
