

A reminder about our school uniform policy, and some upcoming changes for the new year:



- Maroon golf shirts and coloured house shirts are no longer permitted in 2023.
- We have heard your suggestion (parental survey) and moved PE off assembly days. Your child will not have to change into their PE kit on a "formal uniform" day in 2023.
- We have agreed to black bomber jackets (official school jackets -not ones bought at ordinary clothing stores) and have asked our uniform suppliers to increase the padding for greater warmth in winter. Black or maroon bomber jackets can be worn with both the formal and informal uniform.
