

SLEEPOVER INFORMATION



Dear parents

Our infamous senior primary sleepover is rapidly approaching.

Here are some important facts for your attention:

<u>When and where</u>	The “sleepover” officially starts at 17h30 on THURSDAY evening (23 March), so if your child is in After Care they can simply stay at school. If your child is not in After Care, please only drop them off at 17h30 or you will be charged After Care fees! Children have a choice of actually sleeping indoors or outdoors under the stars on the netball court (weather permitting). Either way, there are designated “boy” and “girl” sleeping areas supervised by the teachers.
<u>Teachers on duty</u>	Miss Masemola, Miss Mamapa, Mr Swiegers, Mrs Nothnagel, Teacher Shirley, Teacher Michelle, Miss van Staden and Uncle Darrel
<u>What to bring</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NO PYJAMAS! All children are fully clothed in shorts and t-shirts or tracksuits for the entire sleepover • Bedding to sleep <u>on</u> (we have no mattresses) and <u>under</u>, as well as a pillow • Mozzie repellent • Eye masks/ scarves for the outside sleepers to cover the eyes if they are light-sensitive. (For extra safety we do flood the playgrounds with lights during the sleepover and some pupils complain that they “can’t sleep properly in all that light” ☺.) • Torches for fun • Snacks for smiles and extra fuel • Toothbrushes, toothpaste and hairbrushes • Civvies for break-up day on Friday (no uniforms). Children are welcome to wear the clothing they slept in. • PLEASE NOTE: ABSOLUTELY NO TECH DEVICES ALLOWED!! Contravention of this will result in a phone-call asking you to fetch your child.
<u>What we will supply</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pizza for supper on Tuesday (choice of Hawaiian, Regina and Vegetarian) • Cold drink • Marshmallows and sticks for roasting at our bonfire on the court • Muffins and apples for breakfast on Wednesday morning
<u>Cost</u>	R100 per ticket. Tickets sales will close on FRIDAY morning (17 March). We will not sell any more tickets after this, sorry. We do need our numbers settled in advance to order the food.
<u>Where do the children “set up camp”</u>	<p>If your child is in After care, please drop off all luggage and bedding in the After Care centre - the carpeted side - on the morning of the 23rd. If your child is arriving at 17h30 on the evening of the 23rd, they can “set up camp” directly:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On the netball court (girls’ side is the “house side” and boys’ side is Maraboe Street side) – supervised by Mr Swiegers, Mrs Nothnagel, Teacher Shirley, Teacher Michelle and Miss van Staden • In Ms Masemola’s class (girls only) – supervised by Ms Masemola • In Ms Mamapa’s classroom (boys only) – supervised by Ms Mamapa <p>Children can play on the playgrounds from 17h30 until lights out at 22h00.</p>
