2024 Enrolments officially open...

Please communicate with all friends and family that our enrolments for 2024 will officially open in the new term (17 July). Please enrol early, especially for Grade R and 1, as these spaces fill up quickly.



<u>Application for Grade RRR (3 years old) and Grade RR (4 years old)</u>: come in for an interview on any Tuesday or Wednesday morning from 7h30 until 13h30 (or on other days by appointment). The interview is about 20 minutes long.

<u>Applications for Grade R:</u> come in for testing on any Friday morning at 8h00 sharp. The test is an hour long.

<u>Applications for Grade 1:</u> come in for testing on any Friday morning at 9h00 sharp. The test is an hour long.

<u>Applications for Grade 2-3</u>: preferably come in on Mondays, Tuesdays or Thursdays between 7h30 and 12h30 (or on other days by appointment). The test is about an hour to $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours long.

<u>Applications for Grade 4-7:</u> come in on any school morning between 7h30 and 11h00. The test is approximately 2 hours long (Mathematics and English).



Parent's survey 2023...

At the beginning of next term, we will be sending out our annual school survey for families to give their feedback. This survey is a very powerful tool for parents to make suggestions and give their opinions regarding the policies and management of our school. If you have anything that you would like to have addressed in the survey, please email this to the office before the first week of next term. E.g. in previous years it was requested by a parent that we introduce black school bomber jackets instead of maroon. This was put in the survey, and the majority vote of the parents led school management to introduce the change you see today.
