Preschool bicycle day...

Please remember that it is "Bicycle Day" for Grade RRR-R on Friday. We will be making our own "Jo'burg traffic jam" in the parking lot and enjoying the thrill of joining 100 other cyclists while following "the rules of the road", set out by our teacher-traffic officers. Little cyclists MUST wear helmets please. We can store bicycles in classes overnight if you need to drop off and collect your child's bicycle earlier or later. Scooters and any other wheelie devices are also allowed.

Collection times...

It's one week to exams, and we are changing our collection times from next week onwards. Please note the following collection dates and times and notify your transports accordingly:

Preschool (Grade RRR-R):

14 June - 22 June children collected at 12h30 daily.

Grade 1-3:

14 June - 22 June children collected at 12h45 daily.

Grade 4:

13 - 21 June children collected at 10h00 (gates are locked at 10h20) **OR** at 13h00 if parents can't make 10h00. No child may be collected between 10h20 and 13h00.

22 and 23 June are optional (non-compulsory) school days for Grade 4.

Grade 5-6:

14 - 15 June children collected at 13h00 daily.

19-22 June children collected at 10h00 (gates are locked at 10h20) **OR** at 13h00 if parents can't make 10h00. No child may be collected between 10h20 and 13h00.

Grade 7:

13, 15, 21 June children collected at 13h00.

19, 20, 22 June children collected at 10h00 $\bf OR$ at 13h00 if parents can't make 10h00. No child may be collected between 10h20 and 13h00.

School breaks up on 23 June at 10h00. This is a non-compulsory, optional school day for all grades. Grade 1-7 reports are only given out in the first week of Term 3. Grade RR and R pupils will be tested for next grade in the first week after the school holiday.

Our third term starts on Monday the 17th of July, unlike government schools which start on the Tuesday. After Care is open throughout the holidays.
