

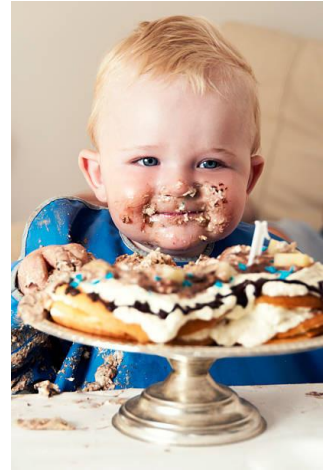

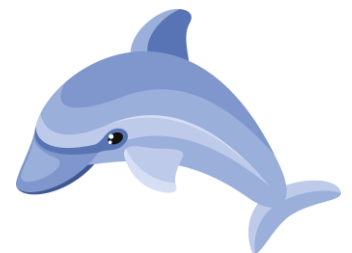
### Lost and found...

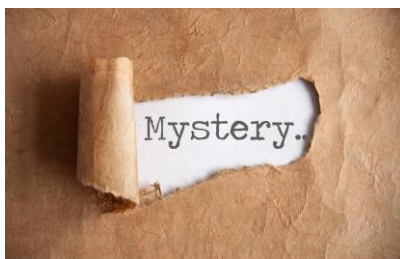
### Splashing into spring...
