Stall owners can set up ANYWHERE on the school playgrounds from 7h30 onwards, but the Market Day will officially begin at 9h00 and end at 12h00.

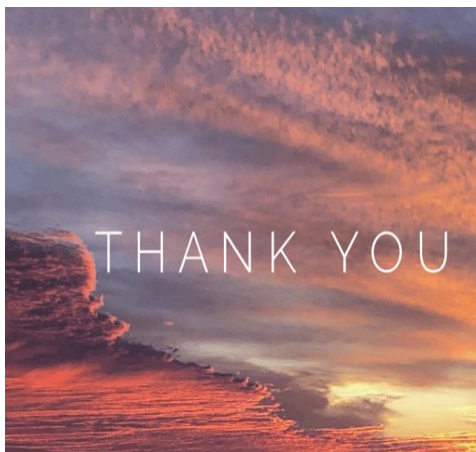
If you are setting up a stall, please remember the following...

### Bossing those bossy Grade 7s!

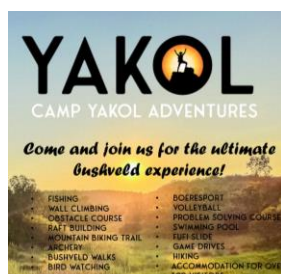
