Remember that your OUTINGS, SHOWS and STATIONERY fee is due TOGETHER with your school fees payment for February within the next two weeks.





Speech therapy..



Did you know that our school has a speech therapist who does therapy during school hours at our school?

Speech therapy not only improves speech problems, pronunciation and elocution, but can also improve a child's auditory processing skills and spelling. If you would like your child to be briefly screened by our therapist to determine if therapy would benefit your child, please complete the attached form and return to school by Friday.

Coding and Robotics (C&R classes)...

We are excited to announce that Coding and Robotics (C&R) 101, 102, and 103 will be starting next week for Grades 5-7. Your child may only sign up for 102 if they have successfully completed 101; and likewise, your child may only sign up for 103 if they have successfully completed 101 and 102. Coding 101 is open to all Grade 5-7 children at no cost. Please email Mrs Mac at the school using bmcintosh@solidfoundationsprimary.com (or use the general school email address) in order to register your child for Coding.



- · Coding 103 will be held on Tuesdays and Fridays at 07:00 sharp, with Mr Swiegers in his classroom;
- Coding 102 will be held on either Mondays and Wednesdays OR Tuesdays and Fridays at 07:00 sharp, with Teacher Shirley in her classroom; and
- Coding 101 will be held on either Mondays and Wednesdays OR Tuesdays and Fridays at 07:00 sharp, with Mrs Mc in her classroom.

Spaces are limited, so children will be allocated to a class according to grade and on a first come, first served basis. Once the class is full your child will be placed on the waiting list for the following intake. You will receive an email as soon as your child has been assigned to a class with the starting date and day of your child's first lesson.

Coding and Robotics (C&R) for Grade 4 has already started with Mrs Obbes in her classroom. If you did NOT sign your child up for C&R Level A at the parents' meeting on Saturday, 20 January 2024, and still wish to do so, then you may email bmcintosh@solidfoundationsprimary.com (or the general school email) to secure their place in the third or fourth sessions to be started later in the term.

Please be advised that if your child is late and / or misses a lesson, they may be required to miss out on the balance of the course and start again with the next intake.
