Camp Konka news...

Our Grade 5-7 pupils are heading off to camp on **SUNDAY morning** at 7h30. Pupils NOT attending camp (Grade 4-7) may remain at home, but must be back at school to collect their reports on break-up day (5 December). Here are a few last-minute reminders for our campers:



- 1. As it is a more luxurious camp venue than usual this year, pupils do NOT need to bring cutlery, crockery or bedding. Please limit your suitcase or bag size to "medium".
- 2. Any tuck money must be placed in an envelope with your name clearly marked on it, and given to Mr Swiegers before you climb on the bus.
- 3. Any medicine must be clearly labelled and given to Miss Mamapa before you climb on the bus. Remember don't bring medicine "just in case". Our staff do have medicine for basic mild ailments in their first aid kits. It is ONLY prescribed medicine that should be given to Miss Mamapa.
- 4. Pupils may not bring cell phones or "tech devices". Please also ensure that they are dressed appropriately for a fun camp (no jewellery or make-up please).
- 5. Lastly, remember a snack pack for WEDNESDAY the 4^{th} of December as children are usually ravenous on their trip home (even after a big breakfast). <u>Campers can be fetched at 12h00</u>.

Sharpening the pencil...

A reminder that <u>Grade RRR through to Grade 4 pupils</u>, get stationery given to them at the start of the school year. Parents can purchase satchels or backpacks (Grade RRR-R) and sturdy suitcases (Grade 1 upwards). However, Grade 1-7s, please ensure that your child has got their own basic stationery <u>at home</u> too, to do homework, as the school stationery often remains at school when your child goes home in the afternoons.

<u>Grade 1 and 3 pupils</u>, please keep your blue plastic book bag (the one you take home daily) and your chair bags from 2024, as you will re-use them in 2025.

For our <u>Grade 5-7 pupils</u>, we do not supply stationery packs, so please make sure your child has got the following basic stationery for 2025:

- -pencil bag
- -blue pen
- -HB pencil
- -sharpener
- -eraser
- -30cm long ruler
- -coloured pencils
- -scissors
- -Pritt glue
- -coloured pens /fine liners (felt tip pens) for studying



- -highlighters (used in class too)
- -homework diary (any type but light weight is recommended)
- -non-scientific calculator
- -Maths set
- -coloured plastic A4 envelopes/ coloured bookbags to keep different subject books together in your suitcase
