


Mind your manners...

Hair rule reminder...

A reminder that if you are planning to grow your son's hair longer, afros are permitted, but there must be a "fade in" from clipper length nr 1 to 2, to 3 etc. around the base of the head and ears, up towards the afro. We do not permit comb-overs or "steps", or hair to touch a boy's ears. Please also remember that you may not shave patterns or paths into your hair. Girls may not have dyed or "loose" hair, but are permitted braids, silver beads, clear beads and a variety of black, white or maroon hair accessories. Extensions and braids may only be exactly the same colour as the child's hair or, in the case of darker hair, colour black 1,2 or 4. Change to financial policy...

In the spirit of fairness to all of our families that pay for January and start schooling on the 15th, we are adding to our financial policy the following clauses, which will impact "late enrollers":

- Pupils enrolling between the 15th and 22nd of January (first school week) are still liable for paying the full January fee.
- Pupils enrolling between the 22nd of January and the 7th of February (half way in the second week of school and up to and including the first week of February) are liable for paying half of January's school fees.
- Pupils enrolling after first week of February (7th February onwards) and up to the end of the second week of February (14th February) are liable for paying the full February fee.
