School term end schedule...

Our seniors are writing exams and we remind you that pupils may leave school either at 10h00 - 10h20 or after 13h00 but NOT ANY TIME BETWEEN 10h20 and 13h00. Please check your child's exam timetable to be sure that they are not writing two exams on one day. If they are, you can only collect them at 13h00 on those days.

Grade RRR to Grade 3 will be having classes and collection times as per normal.

The Grade 2 teachers have specifically requested that you do not collect any Grade 2 pupils early (at 10h00 with their older exam-writing siblings), as they are in the throes of assessing at present.

After Care will be open during the holidays (included in permanent members' monthly fee). We charge R100 per morning (7h30 - 12h00) and R100 per afternoon for non-permanent members who want to join. Please use the gate adjacent to the hall and teachers' parking lot (Korhaan Street) during the holidays. If you are planning on dropping off before 7h30, you can make private arrangements for the school gate to be opened by Uncle Darrel (078-294-5101).

Report dates and school readiness tests...

Our Term 2 reports will be released in Term 3 on the 29th of July for Grade 1-7.

A reminder that our preschoolers only receive two reports annually, and do not receive termly reports. Our Grade RR and R pupils will begin the second week of Term 3 with their school readiness tests. These are standardised tests we use to determine the child's readiness for the next grade. The minimum requirement level is 60% overall. Feedback on our children's scores in these tests will be released by the 3rd week of Term 3.
