Camp is an invaluable experience for our children. We do understand that many of our Grade 5 pupils have never been on a camp and have never been on their own, away from home, for 3 nights. 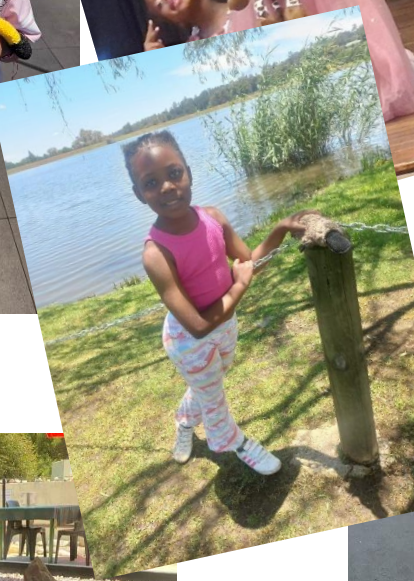
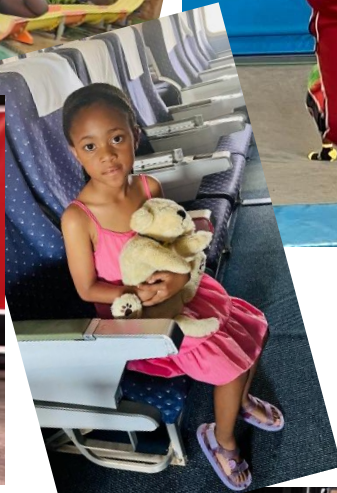
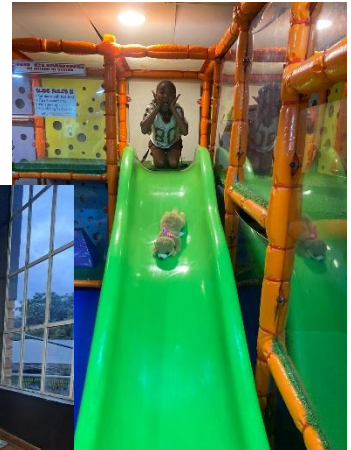
