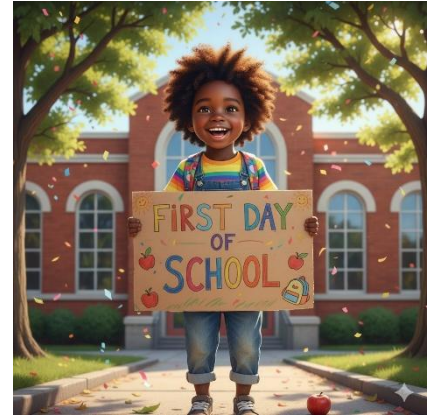

## First Day news...

We're off to a great start. Well done for your child's sparkly appearance and happy smile!



## Parents' Meeting confirmation...

Don't forget our Parents Meeting this Saturday morning the 17th. Give yourself at least 10 minutes to get from your car to your venue and please be on time.

Note the following times and venues for the different grades:

**Grade RRR - 4:** 8h00

**Preschool** will meet outdoors on the netball court - weather permitting. Wear sunhats or bring coats, depending on the weather 😊.

**Grade 1-3** meet in homeroom classes.

**Grade 4** meet in the hall.



*If preschool parents have heard the welcome/introductory speech given by Teacher Kathy in previous years (i.e. speech covering the reading programme, vocab programme, play-based education, cake sales etc.), you are welcome to skip the talk and only come in at 8h45 for a meet-and-greet with your child's new teacher.*

**Grade 5-7:** 9h00 in the hall (compulsory for Grade 5, but optional for Grade 6&7)

Due to space constraints, remember, only one parent can attend (per class). If you are unable to attend, you are welcome to send another family member or friend to represent you. Please also note that the meeting is for grownups, not for little people, who will have to stay at home.

Our extra-mural coaches and companies will also be present to give you information and answer any questions you may have.

## Time to download D6...

Our school uses a free App to assist in communicating with you.

Please can you go to your app store and download the D6 Communicator App. D6 has mentioned that they will be discontinuing the D6 Connect App (the D6 App with the grey icon) and will only be using the D6 Communicator App (the D6 App with the blue icon) going forward.

You can use the D6 App for:

- Quick access to school policies, terms and assessment plans
- Daily homework (Grade 1-6)
- Receiving urgent "WhatsApp"-type alert messages from the school e.g. "netball is cancelled today!"
- Quick access to the Grade RRR-R vocabulary words

Please contact us if you cannot log in to the D6 Communicator App using your cellphone number or email. Please also let us know if you are only getting homework uploaded for one child and you have two or more children in our school.



### Healthy food policy...

Solid Foundations has a healthy lunch policy. It is really difficult to police this, but we are appealing to you to not send chips, fizzy cool-drinks, sweets and cookies in your child's lunchbox during the week. The exception to this rule is Friday lunch. On Fridays, you are welcome to spoil your child with more junk food.

We also strongly recommend water instead of juice in your child's bottle because we do have bees at school.

Don't forget that we sell hotdogs for R15 on Fridays, and pizzas for R40. Pizza orders must be placed on THURSDAY mornings in the office, so we can forewarn Romans Pizzeria at Norkem Mall. Hotdogs and tuck can be bought on Fridays without pre-ordering.



### Extra murals here we come...

Most of our extra-murals launch in February. Please contact your extra-mural coach directly if you would like more clarity. We have done our utmost to update telephone numbers, days and prices on our school website

([www.solidfoundationsprimary.com](http://www.solidfoundationsprimary.com)). A reminder that payment collection and

administration of extra-murals is the responsibility of the private coaches and extra-mural teachers, so don't make payments to the school account for any extra-murals please. Some extra-murals will have uniform requirements. Please respect their stipulations, as they are permitted to decline your child's participation if your child doesn't wear the uniform. You are welcome to meet the extra-mural coaches at our Parents' Meeting on Saturday.



### Stationery top up...

Our school does sell basic stationery items in the office. Feel free to use this facility. We can add the price of these items to your school account.

### Preschoolers...we need your help...

We have a few extra requests for our little people in Mickey Mouse (Grade RRR to Grade R). Please bring the following items in your school bag:

1. An old grown-up's t-shirt to use as an apron for painting every day. This must be packed in your child's bag every day, as we can't guarantee which days will be the "painty" ones! Please wash the shirt whenever necessary during the year.
2. A sunhat (labelled with your child's name). Our playgrounds are largely shaded, but certain parts get full sun, so let's protect those precious faces. Remind your child to pop on their hat at break time please.
3. A spare change of clothes daily, especially our Grade RRR and RR pupils who are prone to accidents.
4. A box of tissues during the course of the year. This is not compulsory at all, but is always highly appreciated.
5. After Care pupils only... a sheet and small blankie (labelled with your child's name). Naps are a voluntary part of the After Care routine.
6. Moneybags will be given to your child on the first day of school. Please use this for any tuck money (or hotdog money) on Fridays. Write your child's name on the bag and let your child wear it over their neck to keep their money safe.





### Reading and vocab programmes...

We will launch our Grade RRR-2 reading and/or vocab after our Parents Meeting on Saturday. You should get your first bag on Friday next week.

### Preschool junk... (reduce, reuse, recycle)

Please don't forget to feed our school "junk monster" who lives in the storeroom and loves to eat all your rubbish!

His favourite foods are:

- Old calendars and desk pads
- Toilet roll inners and long roll inners ("Glad wrap" and foil rolls)
- Washed (ideally with bleach please) plastic milk cartons and water-rinsed soda bottles

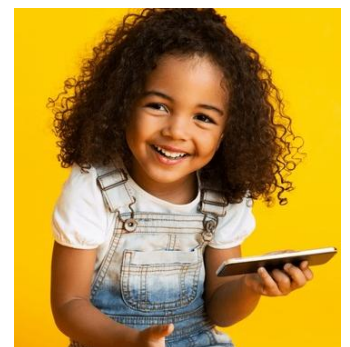
