Dear parents and pupils

Welcome to Solid Foundations After Care 2026

Enjoy the time with us, and here's how we work...

- After Care officially opens on Monday the 5<sup>th</sup> of January 2026. Attendance is, of course, optional. Our times are from 7h30 until 17h30 during the school holidays. Unfortunately, late collection (after 17h30) is frowned upon and will be charged extra (per every 5 minutes overtime). After Care fees only apply to Grade R-7 pupils, and remain constant (R1000 p.m.) throughout the year, including our full-day service over the school holidays. December fees are half-price at R500, and we close on the 15<sup>th</sup> of December 2026. TEMPORARY After Care is charged at R100 per afternoon (school days) and R200 per day (school holidays).
- Your child will be fed a light lunch between 12h30 and 14h30 daily, depending on what time they get out of class. The menu includes hotdogs, toasted sandwiches, cheese rolls etc. together with cold drink. A snack of fruit or cookies and a cold drink is served at about 15h00. During holidays, lunch is served at 12h30. Most children feel hungry before 12h30, so we do strongly suggest you pack in a sandwich and a piece of fruit to tide them over. The staff are aware of food restrictions and allergies (as per your information forms that you completed). We will provide alternative food options for those who require it.
- Bicycles are welcome during holidays. Please **insure your child wears a helmet for protection.**
- We do not object to your child bringing toys for entertainment-purposes during holidays (excluding electronic devices like cell phones, tablets or lap tops). However, we waiver the responsibility of caring for these toys. Children will need to bring them at their own risk. If your child is going to bring any DVD's, these have to be "PG" or "all ages".
- During school terms, homework is supervised in After Care. We have teachers who can assist your child with homework tasks (except individual reading - please read with your child at home). Homework class is compulsory for all grades. If your child does extra-murals, these might clash with home-work class times, so please be vigilant and check that your child's homework is done at home on these special extra-mural days.
- After Care pupils may wear civvies. Please label school clothing if they are going to change into civvies in the afternoons.

- The school's office is closed during the school holidays and the afternoons. If you urgently need to contact your child or the After Care staff, we have listed our most regular After Care staff's private cell numbers for your convenience. We have obtained their special permission to list these numbers publicly, but please respect their privacy and use these numbers for relevant and urgent calls only.

- The After Care staff do have your contact details and will call you in case of any emergencies. Please always inform us if your contact details change.
- Once school starts, you will be required to sign a form daily when you collect your child. This is not only for security purposes, but simply our way of keeping track of the pupils who are on our After Care register, those who are temporary and need to be charged, and the number of staff members we need to appoint, as well as the extra-mural children who need not be charged. Thank you for your patience in this regard. If for any reason, your child is enrolled in After Care but you decide to collect your child early (12h30 - 13h30), please still sign the register.
- A reminder again that After Care closes on the 15<sup>th</sup> of December 2026. The cost for After Care in December is R500, whether or not your child attends. No resignations for After Care are accepted after the 31<sup>st</sup> of October 2026.

Our After Care has access to beautiful playgrounds and a fun environment. Our staff are loving, kind and patient. We look forward to the year ahead with you!
